AIBD Radio Award 2011 on “Web radio”

Radios are facing the digitalization of their networks, the diversity and the fragmentation of their audience and the new evolution of the market. Radios are now released on various platforms and they have to adapt their contents to the platform and to provide additional and tailor-made services in order to reach a always more demanding audience. In that framework, AIBD will this year award the radio broadcasting organization which have implemented the best Web Radio in terms of: Interactivity, Creativity, Production of specific/additional programmes dedicated to the Web format, Web site architecture/Use/Ergonomics/Archives.

All the programmes will be judged according to the following two criteria

Idea:

- How effective is the web radio?
- Is it properly targeted?
- Is it instructive, creative, entertaining and/or innovative?
- Does it capture and hold attention?

Production values:

- Are the production, sound recording, editing, and mixing quality coordinated so as to enhance the programme?

Dead line

An entry form and a copy of the programme should reach the AIBD **not later than 1st June 2011.**
