

WORLD TV AWARDS 2020 CATEGORY HUMANITY The Best TV Documentary on Youth - Charting the Future

CRITERIA AND REGULATION

Genre: Documentary

Length: Maximum of 60 minutes

All the entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

- 1. The programme must focus on creating deeper awareness among the audience on the theme of youth as 'critical agents of change' by highlighting the role of youth in shaping the world as a stakeholder at all levels.
- 2. The programme must focus on the importance of having youth oriented viewpoints and youth themselves, who are changing the world by their experience, innovation and expertise. It also must highlight issues faced by the youth and show effective solutions to over-coming these challenges, while highlighting the opportunities present as well.
- 3. The programme could either focus on a local, regional or on global point of view.
- 4. The programme should be creative and innovative with the ability to capture audience attention, and offer excellent production values.
- 5. The programme must have been aired or must be scheduled for broadcasting in its originating country on national and/or any private TV network (broadcasting sheet to be provided).
- 6. The programme must have been produced within the last 12 months before the date of submission.
- 7. The programme must be either in English or if in any other language with English subtitles. It can also be a non-narrative piece.
- 8. The programme must be the original work of the entrants. Entrants must be able to demonstrate that they have full copyright clearance on all music, image, artwork and other audio-visual elements used in the programme.

Who can submit an entry?

⇒ Television producers from public service broadcasting organisations, private networks, freelancers etc. are invited to participate in this competition.

How many entries can be submitted?

 \Rightarrow Each producer/organisation can submit up to **2 entries.**

Format requested:

⇒ Programmes can be submitted <u>DVD format</u> or as softcopy*

- ⇒ **3 DVDs** are requested for <u>each</u> programme submitted.
- * All softcopy entries must be of high quality without any playback issues. Successful submissions will receive an email to this effect.

Jury:

Jury members are senior media professionals from various countries and regions.

Winner Prize:

⇒ **US\$5,000.00 cash** in favor of the producer and/or broadcasting organisation

⇒ **A trophy and a certificate** presented by the Asia-Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development (AIBD)

⇒ **A trip to Attend Asia Media Summit 2020** to receive the trophy and the certificate on 4 June 2020, a global media gathering.

Note:

 \Rightarrow The names of the winner and runner-up will be announced at the AMS 2020.

 \Rightarrow The AIBD Director and representatives of the sponsors will hand over the prize to the winner during the AMS.

 \Rightarrow A video clip of the winner's programme will be screened during the AMS as well as during the AIBD General Conference in Laos in 2020.
